Our Story

Preparatory Ballet

Ages 3-6

Băllet basic concepts of posture, spatial awareness, musicality, choreographed and synchronized movement, poise, structure,

basic theatrics, and understanding of ballet terminology.

Attire: Pink Leotard, Pink Skirt, Pink Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes, Hair secured in bun Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black fitted shorts/pants, black ballet or jazz shoes

Preparatory Jazz/Tap/Acro

Ages 3-6

Jazz, tap, and acrobatics combination class. Movement concepts of jazz technique, movement and musicality skills, and basic tumbling skills in a structured instructional class. Creative and theatric movement.

Attire: Black leotard, black shorts/leggings, tan jazz shoes, tan Mary Jane tap shoes, hair secured in bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black fitted shorts/pants, black jazz shoes and black jazz taps

Ballet

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

More disciplined and classical of the dance techniques, ballet serves as the basis of all dance. The purpose is to use movement to express music in a very technical and structured class. The concepts of posture, strength, and flexibility are concentrated on through out the class with graceful and poised expression and style.

Attire: black leotard, black skirt (optional), pink tights (mock seam/seamed preferred), pink ballet shoes (canvas), hair secured in burn

Boys: black tank/fitted shirt, black fitted shorts/pants, black ballet shoes

Pointe:

Must be 11yrs old and has an audition requirement, please inquire! Students must be in prepointe 1-2 years in pointe shoes before coming to pointe.

Prepointe:

Available for any students ages 9 and up currently enrolled in ballet. Students will wear ballet flats until tested and invited for a pointe shoe fitting.

Contemporary Ballet:

Contemporary ballet is a Neo-classical ballet class opposite to classical ballet has abstract elements. It eliminates the formalities and opens up to modern techniques and ideas. Modern ballet style emerged from neoclassical ballet style. *Must be enrolled in ballet.*

Attire: black leotard, black footless tights, pink ballet shoes (canvas), hair secured in bun

Boys: black tank/fitted shirt, black fitted shorts/pants, black ballet shoes

Jazz

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

Movement discipline based on performance skills and technique, turns, leaps, and flexibility elements are practiced through out the class. Musicality and expression is a focus of jazz. Dance as it uses the technique of ballet, but the freeform of stylized movement and choreography.

Attire: black form fitting clothing (leo, tights, leggings, tanks, etc) Tan tights optional. Tan jazz shoes (neoprene split sole jazz

bootie) Hair secured in bun

Boys: black tank/fitted shirt, black fitted shorts/pants, black jazz shoes (neoprene split sole jazz bootie)

Tap

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

Using the feet as instruments, students will explore musicality and artistry through movement and sounds. Tap is introduced with motor skill elements such as balance and foot articulation.

Attire: black clothing (leo, top, tank, tights, leggings, etc) Black Oxford HARD SOLE taps, hair secured in bun.

Boys: black tank/fitted shirt, black fitted shorts/pants, black lace up taps

Acrobatics

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

Flexibility, agility, and strength are the core focus of acrobatics. Using floor gymnastics to dance through acrobatic movement's tunes will learn to properly move through flip and rolls and connect choreography.

Attire: black leotard, black shorts/leggings, barefoot, hair secured in braid or bun

Boys: black tank/fitted shirt, black fitted shorts/pants

Hip Hop

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

Using popular, and appropriate music/movement, Hip Hop is sure to engage your dancer! Students will focus on musicality, isolation and stylized movement with performance expression.

Attire: Self Expression, converse or keds (does not need to be brand name) black sneaker, only used in studio (no outside shoes)

Education

Modern

Ages 10 and up

The development technique for Contemporary Dance. Modern was the first technique to follow Ballet. Using styles of Horton, Graham, Limon, Paul Taylor, and more, students will learn both the history and the importance this style will make in their strength and advanced technique preparation.

Attire: Black Leotard, Black Shorts/Leggings, Barefoot, Hair secured in braid or bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants

Contemporary

Ages 10 and up

<u>Musicality, strength, and flexibility</u> learned in our technique classes are expanded on. This form of dance is popular in commercial dance. *must be enrolled in Modern when new studio opens, until then Technical Development or PBT*

Attire: Black Leotard tank or top, Black Shorts/Leggings, Barefoot or socks, Hair secured in Bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants, Twyla Shoes

Lyrical

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

Musicality, grace, and flexibility learned in our technique classes are expanded on. This form of dance is an expression off of ballet.

*Must be enrolled in ballet with 2 prior years ballet experience or by invitation.

Attire: Black Leotard, Black Shorts/Leggings, Twyla Shoes, Hair secured in Bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants, Twyla Shoes

Musical Theatre

Ages 6 (1st grade) and up

Sing, dance and Act! Musical Theatre brings the ultimate skills of entertainment disciplines together for your future broadway star! Our Musical Theater classes are unique in that we offer a class with a vocal/acting coach as well as a class for broadway dance, the two classes will compliment each other through out the semester working together on performance pieces.

Attire: Black Leotard, Black Shorts/Leggings, Tan Jazz Shoes, Hair secured in Bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants, Black Jazz Shoes

Broadway Heels

Ages 13 and up

All students should learn how to dance in heels! This is not a heels class you would see on Instagram! This class teaches ladies the classy style of dance and the sass of jazz, but the skills necessary to do performance level dancing.

Attire: Black Leotard, Black Shorts/Leggings, Tan Jazz Shoes, Hair secured in Bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants, Black Jazz Shoes

Progressing Ballet Technique

Ages 7 and up

Injury Prevention and Rehabilitation

Progressing Ballet Technique is an innovative program developed by Marie Walton-Mahon for students to understand the depth of training muscle memory in achieving their personal best in classical ballet. Using conditioning exercises and equipment, students will learn in depth body awareness of their core, rotation, feet, and upper body strength and flexibility.

Attire: Black Leotard, Black Shorts/Leggings, Barefoot, Hair secured in Bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants, Barefoot

Technical Development

Ages 7 and up

Leaps & Turns, Stretch and Tone

Technical development is used to back up all of our technique classes and combine levels to inspire creativity, camaraderie, and mentorship as students will help push each other to that next level. Teachers will work basic skills of turns and jumps mixed with some stretch&tone classes to reinforce all of their styles.

Attire: Black Leotard, Black Shorts/Leggings, Barefoot/Twylas/Jazz Shoes Hair secured in Bun

Boys: Black Tank/Fitted Shirt, Black Fitted shorts/Pants

We will never use your technique class time for company rehearsals, they have their own blocks. Any interest in joining our companies, please let us know! We will be happy to set up the right track of classes to obtain that goal and get registration going for Auditions.

Classroom

- Payments due **1st of every month**

Make Up Classes

- Please see make up class schedule, make ups must be made with in 2 weeks of missed class.
- Injuries- Injuries that are feasible to dance with, you should still come to class. Each teacher is equipped with floor exercises to give students to replicate classroom muscle development and flexibility so that students will not regress. We have 2 staffed physical therapy assistants who will work with students privately as well. Students will take notes in class and still be a part of the learning process.

Safety

- For your child's safety, please pick up promptly at end time of class. We cannot guarantee adult supervision in lobby area.
- We encourage you to come into studio a least once a week to check message board/calendar.
- Feel free to leave during class time, just be sure to update your emergency contact info in your DSP portal. Parent observation days will be offered through out the season.
- Lost and Found Items will be behind desk, items will be donated at the end of each month, please check regularly.

Social Media

We appreciate your respect of students and family who choose not to be exposed on social media. We have all media releases with our administration. Feel free to post photos of your child (or if with friends having permission from family). We encourage you to share the photo and video posts from our official studio/company social page that permission will be verified with our releases.

Trials

- We do allow up to 3 trial classes per student, for only 1 week, for free, with a \$25 registration fee.
- OR We encourage you to look into our introductory package which allows you to try every class in your age bracket for 2
 weeks (except full classes) for \$50 and waives your registration fee (\$25). This allows your child to try all styles and meet all of
 our instructors.

Season

-The season runs like an academic school year August-May. These are progressively built classes. Withdrawing from classes or starting late will result in being behind in curriculum and possibly not being able to return back to the same level. Classes are subject to change, classes under 5 students are subject to cancellation (2 weeks notice for both will be given)

Workshops/Masterclasses

- Our studio provides masterclasses and workshops every month with different styles and experiences. These are an additional fee, but ALL students are welcome. We also attend up to 2 dance conventions each year that our academic students can come with us to! These are out of town weekend long dance experiences with current industry professionals.

Policies

Dance Education should be provided with standards, framework, and goals. Each of our genres of dance has a curriculum that sets aside from your traditional studio.

The Dance Company has dance classes for all *levels*, abilities, and interests! We also offer workshops and private lessons through out the year to compliment all of your classes and let you explore other genres to see if you would like to try something new with out committing to a full season!

academic

Dance CAN be just for FUN! It can be for LEARNING, GROWTH, and pure JOY! In our academic technique classes, your child will learn from certified, experienced instructors. Classes will have a studio based curriculum where you can guarantee, track, and set expectations on your child's goals and growth in dance. The classes are structured with an interactive environment where kids will feel comfortable, not pressured, and track their improvements through out their year to build their self confidence and self esteem.

trainee

Dance is difficult to navigate through because it is academics, it is technical, it is artistic, and it is competitive. Our trainee program track is designed to help your student pursue dance at a higher level than academic classes. The combination of classes are tracked so that you can get the most productive use of your dance time and energy. Certain classes work better to compliment each other depending on what you decide to pursue. Trainee level students have opportunities to take additional classes, listed below, to compliment their training. Students at this level also have an opportunity to take extra classes as a demonstrator helping them hone in on leadership skills while getting extra technique practice. This is a great track for our 7th-10th grade students.

apprentice

The apprentice level is for our preprofessional, pre-collegiate dancers. This level will include academic classes, preferably with the trainee track. The element of having a special mentorship program to help students reach their goals of dancing through college or as a career is our focus. MANY schools offer very generous scholarships for dance. At this level we will prepare your students for their next step in their journey of dance. Apprentices will also have the opportunity in our teacher training program and eligible for compensation internships. This is ideal for juniors and seniors.

Much like a school calendar, the dance season is designed with a progressive curriculum, if kids start late, take a break, or quit before the end of the year, they are missing out on developmental skills and cannot be guaranteed their same levels upon return. And that classes can be cancelled or changed a anytime.

I UNDERSTAND THIS STUDIO FOLLOWS A CURRICULUM

Students will be placed by ability and not by age. We do our best to accommodate comfort to be surrounded by peers, but much like a math class, certain skills must be learned before going into the next skill level. We will present twice a year options for testing up in levels (as well as in class observations from teachers). Students in lyrical will also have to be enrolled in ballet, students in contemporary must also be enrolled in modern.

I UNDERSTAND THERE IS A 30 DAY CANCELLATION FEE

Many of our classes are full and on waitlists. If you decide to leave dance or take a break, we must have proper notification to help a new student prepare to get into the class. Also as a business, our financial and staffing planning as well as integrity of class ratios relies on numbers of students per class.

I UNDERSTAND THE DRESS CODE

I understand the dress code is for safety and fairness. We have to be able to see body placement of the children as well as minimize extra clothing, hair, jewelry, and proper shoes for sanitation and safety. When kids are all dressed in black it helps the teacher see the room and correct each child as an individual instead of being drawn to their clothing and completely covered and modest. HAIR MUST BE IN BUN SECURED. We do have bobby pins and hair ties in emergency, but please do not rely on these supplies always being available.

I UNDERSTAND STUDENT MUST BE PREPARED FOR CLASS

Students should have a notebook, pencil, water, and proper shoes for class. We are a curriculum based studio and like to teach the kids terminology history, and help them develop beyond their kinesthetic knowledge of dance.

TUITION IS DUE BY THE 7th OF EACH MONTH

A statement will be sent on the 1st and the 5th as a reminder Later fee of \$5/day will be issued

I UNDERSTAND RECITAL AND COSTUME FEES

If you would prefer to prorate recital and costume fees through out the year, you are welcome to bring a check issued to "Innovative Studios" (we do not accept credit/debit for recital fees) and we will keep a running balance of your payments issued to your balance in February, when fees will be due.
