Costumes:

Costume Deposit-

\$50 deposit for each class due by Feb 28.

If tights are worn with costume, we purchase 2 pairs for you and include in your fee so that all colors/styles match. All costumes will have a garment bag this year!

IF your costume costs more than \$50, An email and hand out will be given with the remainder of the costume fee balance by **March 15, Due April 1.** Costume charges are by how much the costume costs, shipping, and taxes. Teachers are asked to keep costume costs below \$85.

Costume Rules-

Costumes should not be worn except for try on at the studio, picture day, and dress rehearsal/recital. If in more than one dance, must purchase tan leotard (or two piece option depending on costume) you can preorder online at www.busybeeboutique.store/ or at desk for modest changing option, as students change in large dressing room.

Volunteers

We're thrilled to welcome volunteers to assist with backstage duties. We'll be accepting 2 volunteers per class (Prep-Level 2). Volunteers will ensure the safety and organization of the class in the dressing room, assist with costume changes, escort the class to and from the stage, and manage bathroom breaks. Only volunteers will have access to watch the dress rehearsal and can observe their child's dance from backstage. Volunteer forms must be submitted by March 2. Due to anticipated demand, we'll notify volunteers of their selection status by March 24, allowing time to purchase tickets if necessary.
